## CCC/PCA Meeting Minutes

April 1, 2015

Meeting was called to order 6:35 pm

***In Attendance:*** Tom Dobyms, Ken Finney, Chuck Jennings, Joe Korpiel, Chuck Stevenson, Andrew Winterbottom and Welcome to Warren White joining the Board.

***Absent:*** Sanja Brewer, Jon Milledge, Gary Thies

March minutes were approved by Chuck Stevenson and seconded by Joe Korpiel.

***Historian :*** No report

***Treasurer:*** Ken Finney reported our March ending balance at \$19,271 with an established reserve of \$5,000 for contingency. The newly formed finance committee(Ken F. and Tom Dobyms) have reviewed the CCCR finances and updated the projection of income vs. expenses for the remainder of our 2015 fiscal year. The treasurer's report was moved to be approved by Andrew W. and seconded by Warren White.

***Membership:*** This month we have 334 Primary Members, 218 Affiliate Members and 552 Total Members. Joe sent welcome letters to 6 New Members.

***Safety:*** No report

***Driving:*** Tom Dobyms reported a successful autocross academy with 30 attendees followed by the next day autocross day with 65 attendees. As the exit timing lights were jeopardized by a

rambunctious 944, a backup set of timing lights will be ordered to preserve the event in case of malfunction or vehicle abuse. Andrew W. moved to make the purchase and was seconded by Chuck Jennings. Jon Milledge is in the process of organizing the May Driver's Education event at Buttonwillow and registration is currently underway on [MotorsportsReg.com](http://MotorsportsReg.com) as well as for the April Autocross event at the Santa Maria airport venue.

**Activities:** Chuck Stevenson: 35 members attended the monthly breakfast at Scottys March 14th.

The Gimmick Rally was cancelled as only four couples signed-up; needed 15 couples/30 people to reach critical mass. The Parkfield Gimmick Rally last year attracted 75 people!

FESTIVAL of SPEED: for those staying at the Mission Inn, we are trying to arrange a Porsche Parking area; also plan on a reception about 5PM Saturday night that you may attend - - this could be in Tom Dobyns' suite and BYOB. Also, although not formally organized, some will caravan down to the hotel - - check Chuck Stevenson for details.

The April 11 monthly breakfast will be switched from Carla's(date conflict) to Scottys in Pismo Beach.

A tour of the Piedras Blancas Lighthouse is being organized for May 16th with a lunch to precede; the lighthouse tour can accommodate a maximum of 30 people and will cost \$10 per person. Questions to Joe Korpiel.

May 31st is the date for the SLO Concours at the Madonna Meadow and a Porsche Corral will be organized; if the Porsches are to be concours, it would be a "Wash & Shine" and we need a coordinator to lead and define categories.

The Cambria Pinedorado will be a non-starter for CCCR as it is not a good fit.

Octoberfest is being planned as a new-members celebration and we'll organize special activities for children as well as a concours; all this at the Eckford's property. CCCR will partially subsidize this event to uplift attendance from our membership at large.
