Historian : No report

Treasurer: Ken F. reported that we ended the month with a balance of \$27,459.56. The net income from the June autocross event was \$1,612. It is projected that for July we'll run negative cash flow due to no motorsport events or other revenue producing activities.

Membership : Joe K. reported that we still have 343 primary members with an increase to 235 affiliate members for a total of 578 members. Joe sent welcome letters to five new members.

Driving: The June 20 Autocross event was successful with 63 participants; 19 entrants piloted Porsches and 44 entrants drove other makes. We are looking to increase the number of Porsche pilots for future events. Sixteen trophies will be awarded to bracket winners.
