## CCCR/PCA Meeting Minutes

April 3, 2024

The meeting was called to order 5:05 PM at Porsche SLO.

### **Our Board:**

Attending were Joe Shubitowski, Chuck Jennings, Gil Igleheart, Joe Kuntze, Carol Walker, Sanja Brewer, Jeff Bartel, Mark Schilling, Fred Herr, Scot Burns, Andy Winterbottom, Bill Chadwick, Ron Green and Bob Bruington. Absent was Bob Kitamura. Tony Brizzolara was a guest.

**President:** Joe Shubitowski said the results of advertising choices between Porsche SLO and Porsche Santa Barbara were 13 yes for Porsche SLO and 1 no. Joe wrote a note to Rene at Porsche Santa Barbara thanking them for all their help over the years and returned their advertising money. At the President's zoom meeting, Joe said there are six Southern California regions organizing a Zone 8 concours with the judges using Zone 8 rules. There hasn't been much feedback on the newly increased national PCA dues yet. Now, the DE participants must be at least 18 years old. We are going to consider a scholarship to Auto Tech students at Cuesta College. There will be a 55th anniversary party for our club at Porsche SLO in September.

**Vice President:** Bob Bruington said the new sound system has arrived and he needs some help setting it up. He will have the Bylaws after Joe S. makes his corrections.

**Secretary:** Joe Kuntze moved to accept the minutes sent by email, Bill Chadwick seconded and all approved.

**Treasurer:** Bill Chadwick stated we started 2024 with \$42,181 and at the end of March we have \$50,817 in our account. All advertisers have paid except for Rock Chip Armor. Bill went over the Coastalaire advertisers with Chuck. We are going to try using wristbands for our lunches as some people wind up not paying and it is costing the club those meals. Chuck needs a check for Brooks Burgers for \$720 for the signing event at the Stable on 3/30. The club finances are off to a good start, but we still have outstanding DE deposits.

**Membership:** Sanja Brewer reported six new members in the last month, for the first time ever. One transferred in, two transfers out, seven lapsed, 465 total

primary members, 294 affiliate members, totaling 759 members, and four test drive participants.

**Activities:** Joe Kuntze said Chuck's signing event went really well. This Saturday is a drive and dine to Longbranch in Creston, with 17 signed up so far. Joe and Tony coordinated: dates for the Autocross school; 4/20 Paso Brewing; 4/27 Cars and Coffee. Coming up in May is the DE at Buttonwillow, Autocross, and Rustic Fire. Joe is working with Etto and Alligretto for summer dinners. Potentially, a summer picnic might happen too. Gil Igleheart added that we no longer will go to San Simeon Beach Bar and Grill since they are now requiring a deposit for lunches. Fourteen people have signed up for Healdsburg.

Tony Brizzolara extended thanks from the dealership to be the exclusive advertiser in the Coastalaire. They have been successful signing up new members, with four in the last month and fourteen year to date.

**Safety:** Jeff Bartel will get insurance for the Paso event. He needs the dates for the Healdsburg drive. He will add May 18 at Rustic Fire to his list for insurance.

**Autocross:** Fred Herr reported that cleaning out the trailer has started. They still need about 40 new cones at a cost of \$584.13 which includes shipping. The Autocross school and event is full with a wait list. The new canopy tent has arrived.

**Driver's Education:** Bob Bruington reported twenty nine entries so far for Laguna Seca. Buttonwillow has 41 entries and the breakeven point is 65-70, which he expects will happen in the next month.

**Newsletter:** Chuck Jennings will send Scot photos of the mural signing Party to post on the website. Two thirds of the April newsletter is done, it is a print issue but he will send a digital issue first. DE is the least photographed event and Autocross has the most. He is not caught up yet with the Anniversaries announced in the newsletter. There was a discussion about having our email addresses listed in the Coastalaire & we are probably not going to publish them.

**Website:** Scot Burns said Rock Chip Armour was added to our advertisers and Santa Barbara Porsche was removed. The website developer is very interested in coming to our events to photo and video them. It was suggested we allow him a parade lap or a drive with an instructor to video.
