

Treasurer's Report

As your CCCR's treasurer, I would like to give this overview of CCCR's charitable giving for 2024. Some of the best board meetings come in the last couple of months each year when we assess our finances and select local organizations for charitable donations.

With the close of 2024, your board again found that we had room in our budget for some charitable giving - \$12,500 for 2024. The board wanted to keep our donations local, and (because we're a car club) wanted to include some automotive organizations. In the end we selected the following for these donations:

SLO Food Bank • Central Coast Cancer Support Community • SLO Noor Foundation, Cuesta College Auto & Auto Body Foundations • Estero Bay Kindness Coalition • Big Brothers & Sisters of SLO County and MS Society.

CCCR receives funds from several sources every year, 2024's total income was almost \$160,000. The top contributors to our 2024 income were; autocross event fees, advertising in Coastalaire, Porsche Club of America, Porsche San Luis Obispo, and Drivers Education events.

The Club uses these funds to pay for all the fun things we do. We publish Coastalaire monthly with printed and mailed copies every three months. We host our New Member BBQ (special thanks to Jason and Bonnie Len for the use of their ranch), and we subsidize our annual Holiday Party. We host many other activities, and we fund the development of our new award-winning web page, www.cccpca.org.

And we have to give a big Thank You to Porsche San Luis Obispo. They have been a big supporter of the Club with advertising & sponsorship dollars and a generous donation to our Holiday Party. They also give the use of their facility for our monthly Cars & Coffee, as a starting point for most of our driving events, and they host our monthly board meetings.

These sources of income and the fun things in which we invest are all "driven" entirely by volunteers. These are not just board members, but the many members who volunteer to make autocross and DE events work so well, and help with Drive & Dine's, BBQ's, Holiday Parties and other activities.






























December 14 with Joe



Member Profile: Ron Sneddon

I first met Ron on a central coast drive with the Los Osos based Bear Valley Driver Club group in 2020. Ron was in his late '80's at that time and was driving his manual transmission, 2006 maroon Cayman S. I couldn't believe how well he drove that car or how graceful he looked getting in and out of it. I can barely get in and out of my Cayman now. How will I be when I hit my 80's and 90's? Since that first meeting, I have had the good fortune to spend time with Ron at our PCA Club events. In the last couple of years, Ron has started driving in the CCCR track events, starting with the autocross events and now the Drivers Education events. At 91 years old. Who does that? Amazing! We meet just every week for coffee at Carlock's Bakery, along with the other members of the Bear Valley Driver's Club. During our time together I have picked Ron's brain about his life story, car history and how he has kept himself in such great mental and physical shape. Here is what I have learned so far.

Maybe some of you have reached this time in your life too. A time when birthdays are not as welcome as they once were, but much better than the alternative. A time when scheduling vacations revolves around doctor appointments and medical procedures. A time when it's become difficult to ingress and egress (insert Porsche sportscar name here) without the assistance of the Jaws of Life or a visit to the chiropractor. A time when gravity and wear and tear have begun to take their toll on body parts (mine not my Porsche). A time when it's become more and more challenging to continue to do the activities that we love doing. So, when I met Ron Sneddon, fellow PCA California Central Coast Region member, I was intrigued.



Ron was born in Los Angeles on February 19, 1933. He grew up in Inglewood and Whittier. Ron attended Mount San Antonio College and then on to USC. After college Ron worked in the Aerospace Industry for 13 years and 28 more years as an engineer in the development and manufacture of computer disk memory. He married Alma (his wife for 59 years) in 1954. They raised four wonderful sons Mathew (CA), Mark (CO), Eric (WA) and Brad (FL). The boys are all at or beyond retirement age after successful careers and keep in touch regularly. The oldest son, Mathew, lives in LA and is a car nut (like his father). Every year since 1984 Mathew and Ron travel to Monterey together to take in the historic car races at Laguna Seca. Both are also confirmed F1 junkies.

Ron has owned several interesting cars in his lifetime. He bought his first car in 1949. It was a 1928 Model A (with a Chevy motor in it). In 1956 he bought his first Porsche, a 1953 356 1500 Super. Unfortunately, it kept breaking crankshafts which was problematic for reliability and hard on the wallet. Since then, Ron has owned a 1967 Mustang Fastback 2+2, a 1975 308 Dino V8 and a beautiful 1974 Alfa GTV pictured exiting Turn 8 at Laguna Seca (notice the vintage Marlboro logos on the curbing).




In 2014 Ron found his beautiful Carmine Red 6-speed Cayman S and it's been his daily driver ever since. He even uses it to commute back and forth to LA to see his fiancée, Susie. Yes, Ron is engaged at 91. Now that's the power of positive thinking!

I guess what interested me most about Ron (other than his intelligence, memory and love for life) is how he is able to stay so physically active at his age. What I discovered is that Ron is very disciplined in his approach to diet and exercise. He follows Dr. Jason Fung's intermittent fasting program, doesn't eat sugar, limits his carb intake, drinks 1-2 protein smoothies every day and doesn't drink alcohol. For exercise Ron goes to the gym 3-4 days per week, works out with a physical trainer 2 times a week and regularly uses his home rowing machine.



I'm trying my best to incorporate some of Ron's regimen into my daily routine. Like Ron, I want to be able to do the things I love for as long as possible. I am now using his physical trainer and exercising regularly. However, the diet parts of Ron's longevity recipe have been tougher to follow, especially that no sugar (I love to bake) part and that no alcohol....



If you get a chance to meet Ron, spend some time with him. You will be glad you did.



Ladies! Ladies! Are you letting your significant other have all the fun on Porsche Driver Education Track and Autocross events? Grab your helmet (or rent one from us) and come out and see what all the fun is about!

I would like to introduce you to a lady that knows all about the excitement of being on the track and is one of the better drivers in our CA Central Coast Region PCA Club. Her name is **Carissa Teixeira.** In 2022 Carissa attended Fastlane Racing School and completed the training to get her SCCA full competition Racing License. In 2023 she attended the Porsche (PCA) Instructor School and is now a Porsche APPROVED driving instructor. Let's find out a little more about her.



Carissa was born and raised into an agricultural family in Santa Maria, CA. By the age of 12, she had begun driving her father's truck around their 200 acre farm. By the time Carissa was 16 she had become skilled at towing and backing trailers with ease. In her early 20's she received her ambulance driver's license, but due to accumulating too many speeding tickets, was unable to secure a position and had to find another career.

One Saturday, Carissa happened to be driving past the Santa Maria Airport and witnessed one of our Autocross events taking place. She instantly thought, "I want to do that!" Despite only having a full-sized Ram 1500 crew cab truck, she didn't let that deter her. She registered and was the only truck entered. Impressively, she placed well and couldn't wait to continue. This led Carissa to realize that if she could drive a full-sized truck through the obstacle course without hitting any cones, she could certainly do it even more quickly with a car.

For several years, Carissa continued to participate and progress in Autocross, and thoroughly enjoyed it. One day Bob Bruington mentioned that, since she enjoyed autocross so much, she should try one of the club's Driver Education (HPDE's) track days. So Carissa attended CCCR's next track event at WeatherTech Raceway. It turned out that Bob was right, and Carissa was hooked on driving the track at speed!

Carissa says, "The PCA Central Coast Club is an excellent, well-organized group and everyone is very welcoming and friendly. Driving on the track eliminates all the everyday stress and it is truly my happy place. Additionally, if any of you ladies are seeking an adrenaline boost, it definitely provides that too. If you can follow instructions, stay alert, and maintain a safe and calm demeanor while driving, I urge you to sign up for a Driver's Education autocross or track day. It will not disappoint you!"

There you have it ladies, straight from one of our best. We would love to see you out there on the autocross course or the track. Carrissa and other instructors are looking forward to working with you. Instruction for autocross and track days is free for all ladies. CCCR will have seven autocross dates – one for ladies only on May 18 – and one academy for first timers, and three Driver Education track events in 2025. Drivers Education 2025

Winter is usually the time when Drivers Education track days take a break, but for the last several years, more and more track days are available during the winter months. The PCA regions are fairly quiet this time of the year but many commercial track companies have track day events throughout the year. The schedule for CCCR is set with our first event on May 30th at the new track at Buttonwillow, then on to Laguna Seca only a month later on June 30th, and then a slight break until Nov. 1st on the original course at Buttonwillow. CCCR is the only PCA club to have a date at Laguna Seca this year. There are many track days organized by private, for-profit businesses to join all year long at many racetracks in California.

The weather can be tricky through the winter; many of the track events are rain-or-shine events, hence, you may want to wait to register closer to the date of the track day to see how the weather report is for the day and location of the event.

There are many more track days available if you are willing to travel. Ten of our local drivers are planning to attend the Las Vegas Region's DE at Spring Mountain in Pahrump Nevada, on February 22nd and 23rd. About an 8 hour drive, but well worth it for a two day event at one of the best tracks around. Also, there is Sonoma Raceway, 5 hours, Thunderhill, 8 hours, Chuckwalla, 6 hrs away.

The best way to look for available track days is on MortorSports.Reg, a registration site where 90% of all track events are shown. When you do find an event, you need to set up an account which you should have anyway; many of our social events are advertised on the site and you will need to pay for the event through MSR. It does not cost to set up an account and is very easy to do so.

Besides the racetrack events, our fantastic CCCR Autocross team has tentative dates for the 2025 Autocross events. If you are interested in tracking your car, the autocross events are the perfect way to start. See page 26.


