CCCR/PCA Meeting Minutes

January 8, 2025

The meeting was called to order 5:02 PM at Porsche SLO.

Our Board:

Attending were Joe Shubitowski, Joe Kuntze, Sanja Brewer, Fred Herr, Andy Winterbottom, Bob Bruington, Mark Schilling, Chuck Jennings, Jeff Bartel, Bill Chadwick, Scot Burns, Gil Igleheart, and Carol Walker. Tony Brizzolara was a guest.

President: Joe Shubitowski attended the Zone 8 President's meeting in Ontario, where they discussed insurance and liability. They said we should post the insurance at every event. Waivers were discussed. We are to keep those for eight years for major events and 5 years for minor events. They are most concerned about track liability. Other documents to keep for eight years include tech sheets, contracts for tracks, etc. National plans to be more diligent in receiving post event reports. They talked about women's groups in the regions and how to get younger people to join us. September 13 is the PCA anniversary party which we need to be thinking about how to celebrate.

Tony Brizzolara reported that Porsche SLO signed up five new members for the month. This makes a total of 60 for the year from them. He suggested trying to introduce the new members at the events and possibly put their photos in the newsletter.

Vice President: Sanja Brewer reported the Holiday Party was a big success but most people felt the venue was too crowded. The food was good. We will have it there again this next year.

Secretary: The December minutes were emailed, Andy Winterbottom moved to approve the minutes, Bill C. seconded and all approved.

Treasurer: Bill Chadwick emailed his report. Tonight, he said we started the year with \$43,049. He is looking for more advertisers. Andy moved to accept the report, Joe Kuntze seconded and all approved.

Membership: Andy Winterbottom reported there were nine new members, no transfers in, two transfers out, and six lapsed. We have a total of 513 primary

members, 306 affiliate members, for a total of 819 people. There are four test drive participants. The national membership totals 106, 832.

Activities: Joe Kuntze reminded us that the drive to Daniels Wood Land is this Saturday. We will break into three groups of cars with lunch following at Rustic Fire Pizza. January 13 is the board dinner at La Laconda. January 25 is the drive to Los Alamos with lunch at Charlies. This coincides with Cars and Coffee, so we will meet there and then leave about 10:30. February 8 is the Valentines lunch at Buona Tavola in Paso Robles. February 15 is a shop tour in Paso Robles. April 5 is a wine class at the Wine Academy. Chuck suggested we should think about having a brunch after Cars and Coffee and asked for suggestions for a brunch venue. He is working on another mural at the Longbranch Saloon and would like to host another signing party.

Safety: Jeff Bartel has all the insurance up to date for the January events and will start working on February events.

Autocross: Fred Herr gave the dates for upcoming Autocross events as follows: April 5-6 is the Autocross Academy; May 18 is the women's only Autocross; June 21, July 26, September 6 and October 4 are the remaining Autocross dates. The not so good news is he received an email from the airport stating we have our full lease until May, then it will convert to a month to month basis in June. It is looking like we will have to find another Autocross venue. February and March he will clean out the trailer. We might need more cones but he wants to wait to spend any money until we see if we can continue to use the track.

Driver's Education: Bob Bruington told us there are new guidelines for 2025. Concerning the tech inspections, any competent PCA member or instructor can inspect the car. There are new tech sheets. The incident report is specifically to be sent to PCA national insurance and no one else. We are the only region to be hosting an event at Laguna Seca this year so it should be a great turnout. He is thinking about an instructors school for November and is looking for mentors. The May 30 event is at Buttonwillow and June 30 will be at Laguna Seca.

Newsletter: Chuck Jennings is working on the January issue. It is 90% complete and features the Holiday Party. It will go to print next week. He will add articles about the new members in the coming issues.

Website: Scot Burns said there were 5,643 total page views with 2,400 new viewers. Ninety two percent are new people looking at the web page. The developer is looking at Laguna Seca videos to incorporate and post on the web page. He suggested possibly adding forums to the web page, It's just a suggestion.
