CCCR/PCA Meeting Minutes

July 9, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 4:58 PM at Porsche SLO.

Our Board:

Attending were Joe Shubitowski, Joe Kuntze, Andy Winterbottom, Bob Bruington, Mark Schilling, Chuck Jennings, Jeff Bartel, Sanja Brewer, Scot Burns, Bill Chadwick and Carol Walker. Gil Igleheart and Fred Herr were absent. Tony Brizzolara and Jason Len were guests.

President: Joe Shubitowski introduced Jason Len who presented an idea for an event. He proposed a car show that includes arts and crafts, prizes, and raffles to be held in September or October, 2026. It would not be a club event but he would like the club to help sponsor it with support. Joe mentioned the Porsche Parade starts this weekend. The Treffen at Sea has 1,000 people signed up. The Treffen at Jackson Hole sold out in four minutes! At the President's zoom meeting they stressed needing completion of post event reports. He will check out the Porsche Roads app, which might help with our driving event routes. Lori de Cristo wants to come to our region since it is her last year in office, so Joe invited her to the Holiday Party.

Tony Brizzolara said there was a good group at Cars and Coffee. The dealership signed up three new members last month for a total of 85 so far.

Vice President: No report.

Secretary: The June minutes were emailed. Chuck Jennings moved to approve the minutes, Bill Chadwick seconded and all approved.

Treasurer: Bill Chadwick reported our bank total the end of June was \$44,761, up about \$1,712 from the first of the year. The final bill for Laguna Seca was \$30,900 which meant we lost about \$4,000 putting on that event. We have spent all of the \$700 that was donated by The Stable. We removed Rock Chip Armor from advertising in the Coastalaire since they had not paid their invoices. Andy moved to accept the report, Joe Kuntze seconded, and all approved.

Membership: Andy Winterbottom reported there were nine new members, two transfers in, two transfers out, eight lapsed, and four test drives. There are 534

primary members and 322 affiliates, to total 856 members. Nationally, there are 165,141 members. New members names were announced.

Activities: Joe Kuntze said the June 25 meeting at Jason Len's house to discuss potential activities went pretty well. Some suggestions were to keep the drives to 90 minutes, visit the Canepa facility, museums in Southern California, winery tours, the scarecrow event in Cambria, and the Chablis cruise in Morro Bay. Safety: Jeff Bartel has all the insurance for all the upcoming events.

Autocross: Fred Herr reported that the last event was great. He has 31 PCA members signed up for the next event and registration opens to the public next week. He still needs a new printer, which we have authorized him to purchase.

Driver's Education: Bob Bruington reported there were two accidents at Laguna Seca, one involving a Corvette and the other a BMW which were handled well, but otherwise it went smoothly. The Stable picked up a dinner and gave \$200 to raffle off. The 120 day tech requirement will be cut down to 60 days prior to the event. Other areas charge \$300-\$400 for this service. November 1 is a scheduled instructor's school at Buttonwillow. He has six candidates but would like 10. He has a sponsor so there is no cost to us.

Newsletter: Chuck Jennings shared old copies of the Coastaire which showed how much it has evolved over the years. He is working on the July issue which will feature an article on Bob Kitamura.

Website: Scot Burns said that all sessions on the web page are down. Ninety-one percent were new visitors with 413 new people in the last month. All events up to the Holiday party can now be found on the website.
