## CCCR/PCA Meeting Minutes

June 4, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 4:59 PM at Porsche SLO.

### **Our Board:**

Attending were Joe Shubitowski, Joe Kuntze, Andy Winterbottom, Bob Bruington, Mark Schilling, Chuck Jennings, Fred Herr, Gil Igleheart, Jeff Bartel, and Carol Walker. Bill Chadwick, Sanja Brewer, and Scot Burns were absent. Tony Brizzolara was a guest.

**President:** Joe Shubitowski discussed how to encourage more people to step up and run the driving and autocross events. We need to find more people to help on committees with them possibly meeting once a month. The web page should have more of the events up to date.

Tony Brizzolara thanked Bob Bruington for the Buttonwillow experience of the parade lap and taking photos of the event. There was a good crowd for the last cars and coffee. The dealership has a major cleaning coming up and the sales are strong. They signed up 7 new members last month for a total of 83 new members from the dealership.

**Vice President:** No report.

**Secretary:** The May minutes were emailed. Andy moved to approve the minutes, Joe Kuntze seconded and all approved.

**Treasurer:** Bill Chadwick sent the treasurer's report. The current balance is \$56,316. We made approximately \$600 on the Buttonwillow DE. The bulk of his report was sent via email. Andy moved to accept the report, Joe Kuntze seconded, and all approved.

**Membership:** Andy Winterbottom reported there were ten new members, zero transfer in, zero transfer out, twelve lapsed, and two test drives. There are 531 primary members and 320 affiliates, to total 851 members. Nationally, there are 164,744 members.

**Activities:** Joe Kuntze reminded us about the Saturday drive to Jalama Beach for burgers. Upcoming events are as follows

**Safety:** Jeff Bartel has all the insurance for Jalama Beach drive, the Ragged Point drive, the autocross event for June, and for the Laguna Seca DE.

**Autocross:** Fred Herr reported that both autocross events went well. The Saturday event had 68 drivers. Ladies Day was a big hit with 17 ladies that drove sixteen laps. He used the airport waivers that were filled out ahead of time. The June autocross is 99% full. The July autocross will be open for registration on June 23. There might be about \$100 left from the donation from The Stable. The timing software needs it's annual check up which will cost \$425.

**Driver's Education:** Bob Bruington said that the Buttonwillow DE made \$600 profit and had no incidents. The upcoming Laguna Seca event is far behind in signups with only 34 signed up so far which translates to \$17-18,000 deficit. We need at least 70 participants to break even. There will be an instructors school at Buttonwillow on November 11. He will be sending out an email to see who might be interested in attending. We had a discussion about whether to continue with offering a DE at Laguna Seca and we will revisit that discussion in a few months.

**Newsletter:** Chuck Jennings reported the June issue of the newsletter will feature Ed Swain. The last print issue cost \$4,400 due to being a bigger issue and a larger mailing list.

**Website:** Scot Burns is trying to figure out a way to get a link to Facebook. The developer, Kamil, didn't have time to figure this out yet. Sessions were up 23% from the previous month and the average session duration was 1 minute 6 seconds, up 3%. There were 92% new users. Mobile usage has significantly increased.
