## CCCR/PCA Meeting Notes

September 3, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 4:59 PM at Porsche SLO.

### **Our Board:**

Attending were Joe Shubitowski, Andy Winterbottom, Mark Schilling, Chuck Jennings, Jeff Bartel, Sanja Brewer, Scot Burns, Bill Chadwick Gil Igleheart, Fred Herr and Carol Walker. Joe Kuntze and Bob Bruingrton were absent. Tony Brizzolara was a guest.

**President:** Joe Shubitowski attended an executive meeting with PCA on August 18 where they discussed the Porsche Parade, which had low attendance. They reported that our total national membership has increased. Another PCA meeting reported the PCA red book is now online; they are looking for a West Coast sponsor for racing events; our board meeting minutes are now to be called "NOTES"; and Lori diCristo is now termed out as Zone 8 representative.

Tony Brizzolara said there was a good group at Cars and Coffee, with 149 people signed up in attendance. The dealership signed up seven new members last month.

**Vice President:** Sanja reported the holiday party menu will be available next week and she will present it at the next board meeting. She applied for a subsidy from National for the New Member BBQ which will give us \$500 from PCA.

**Secretary:** The August notes were emailed. Chuck Jennings moved to approve the notes, Mark Schilling seconded and all approved.

**Treasurer:** Bill Chadwick reported at the start of the year our bank account showed \$43,049 and as of the end of August we had \$52,759. Last year at this time we had \$59,103. Buttonwillow registrations are starting to come in and we received a \$600 check for advertising from Altitude Home Loans. We lost \$481 on the LeVigne dinner and have spent \$1,667 so far on the New Member BBQ. Andy moved to accept the report, Chuck seconded and all approved.

**Membership:** Andy Winterbottom reported there were nine new members, two transfers in, one transfer out, seventeen lapsed, and five test drives. There are 527 primary members and 325 affiliates, to total 852 members. Nationally, there are 166,714 members. New members names were announced.

**Activities:** Gil Igleheart talked about preparations for the New Member BBQ. Joe Kuntze will pick up the cake from Albertsons. The tables and port-a-potties are paid for, there are enough tablecloths, there will be 5 people at the sign in table, and signs will be posted with arrows to funnel people to the registration table. This Saturday's event is a drive to Atascadero for a shop tour and BBQ lunch.

**Safety:** Jeff Bartel has the insurance for this weekend's drive and dine and will have the insurance for the New Member BBQ soon.

**Driver's Education:** Bob Bruington was absent but sent a note saying that the Buttonwillow DE and instructor training class is all set.

**Autocross:** Fred Herr stated the last autocross went really well. October 25 will be the last one of the year. There was a discussion about having an autocross in Santa Margarita at least once to test out the potential venue there. He needs trophies but the price has increased to about \$100 per trophy and we need 12-15 trophies. A video was created for autocross events that will be featured on our web page with a link to registration for those events.

**Newsletter:** Chuck Jennings described the adventure tour, photo rally and drive/dine planned for October 11 out of San Miguel on backroads to finish up with lunch in King City. There are services at the start at the Mission Market and Deli, but none until arriving at the Cork and Plough restaurant. The September issue of the Coastaire will go out the end of the week.

**Website:** Scot Burns said the login to the web page is not functioning and is trying to fix it. The plugins are updated as well.

**Director at Large:** Mark talked about the need for instructions for drivers at Buttonwillow.
